### Your Imagination

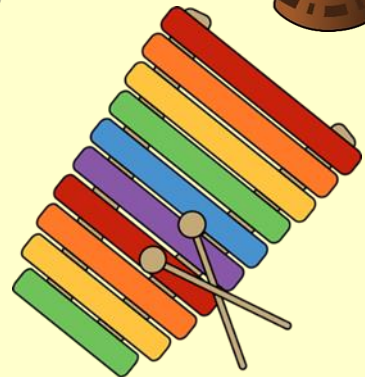
- \*Identify instruments played in a song.
- \*Create rhythms using word phrases as a starting point.
- \*Compose a simple melody using simple rhythms choosing from notes C + D or C, D + E.
- \*Class performance (with singing and playing glockenspiels).



## Spring

### In the Groove

- \*Listen to and find out about six musical styles: Blues, Baroque, Latin, Irish Folk, Funk.
- \*Copy and clap back rhythms.
- \*Create rhythms using word phrases as a starting point.
- \*Compose a simple melody using simple rhythms.
- \*Class performance (with singing and playing glockenspiels).
- \*Talk about how the performance made them feel



## Autumn

### My Musical Heartbeat

- \*Find and keep a steady beat, including when improvising.
- \*Play or clap simple rhythmic patterns (four beat rhythms) using long and short sounds.
- \*Respond to different high and low pitches.
- \*Improvise using one, two or three notes.
- \*Respond to questions about the music.
