Summer

Buddism: What is the best way for a Buddhist to lead a good life?

- Describe how aspects of the 8fold path would help Buddhists know how to live good lives.
- Understand why some aspects of the 8-fold path might be hard for some Buddhists to stick to.

<u>Christianity:</u> Do people need to go to church to show they are Christians?

- Describe some of the ways Christians use churches to worship/celebrate Holy Communion.
- How baptisms are celebrated.
- Understand the impact a Christian's special place has on him/her.

Spring

Buddism:

Could the Buddha's teachings make the world a better place?

- Recall one of the Buddha's stories and explain what the Buddha was teaching through it.
- Give an example of how Buddhists could learn from stories.



Autumn

Is forgiveness always possible for Christians? Describe what a Christian

Christianity:

- Describe what a Christian might learn about forgiveness from a Biblical text.
- Show an understanding of how Christians believe God can help them show forgiveness.





Buddism: <u>Is it possible for everyone to be happy?</u>

- Understanding some of the things Siddhattha did to try to be happy and explain why they didn't work for him.
- Understanding what being happy means to Buddhists.

Christianity: What is the most significant part of the Nativity story for Christians today?

- Describe one thing a Christian might learn about Jesus from a Christmas symbol.
- Ask questions about what Christmas means to Christians.
