# How we teach reading

- Daily phonics sessions
- Opportunities for reading during LTP (Learning Through Play)
- Group reading sessions



# Phonics Lesson

- Review previous sounds taught
- Teach new sound
- Practise new sound in reading and writing
- Activity to secure knowledge



# Group Reading sessions

- Children in small groups
- Read with an adult 3 times a week (twice with teacher 1 with a trained TA/EYP)
- Independent activities to promote fluency and reading opportunities



# Group Reading sessions

- Books matched according to children reading  
90% words fluently
- 1<sup>st</sup> session – word reading and fluency practice
- 2<sup>nd</sup> session – prosody
- 3<sup>rd</sup> session – comprehension – book goes home



# Why fluency is important

Fluent decoding allows us to understand what we read. Because the reader has gained accuracy and automaticity in word reading, the brain's resources are available to focus on lifting the meaning from the page: connecting the words, sentences and text. As children gain fluency, their motivation increases: they start to enjoy reading more and are willing to do more of it.

# Group Reading sessions

- Teachers constantly assess children's reading
- Not all books in the sequence need to be read
- There is a wide range of books so all children's needs can be met




# How you can help at home
