In Year One, children are heard to read at least twice a week through Guided Reading sessions. This is where children read in a small group. Each child is heard to read individually, as well as reading skills being taught.

Please continue to help your children to remember to bring their reading books and reading record into school every day. They will receive a new Monster Phonics book, and change their 'Sharing at Home' books, weekly.

The children will continue to bring home a White Rose Maths Practice Journal most weeks. We are also going to start sending home spellings to practise at home.

No more than 35 minutes should be spent on these tasks altogether.
