

Curriculum Map Year 5 Autumn Term 2024

English

This term, we shall be journeying into a galaxy far, far away.

Text we are studying: Origami Yoda, Curiosity – Mars Rover, Unexplained Mysteries, Anne Frank. **Key Learning:**

Children will have the opportunity to draft and write a range of fiction genres and non-fiction texts, which will work towards the following extended written outcomes:

- Select appropriate grammar and vocabulary, understanding how such choices can change and enhance meaning
- Writing balanced arguments, diaries, explanation texts, letters, newspaper recounts, persuasive writing.

Class reader(s): Warhorse by Michael Morpurgo

Key Vocabulary: Adjectives, suffixes, prefixes, paragraph, cohesive devices, adverbials, synonyms and antonyms.

At home you can: Hear your child read/read to them x 5 per week. Practise spellings.

Maths

Key Learning:

In maths we will be focusing on:

- Reading, writing, ordering and comparing numbers up to 1,000,000.
- Adding and subtracting whole numbers with more than four digits using formal written methods.
- Exploring solving problems in different ways.
- Understanding factors and multiples.
- Multiplying and dividing by 10, 100, 1000.
- Understanding and calculating with fractions.

Key Vocabulary: hundred, thousand, ten thousand, hundred thousand, million, value, addition, subtraction, multiplication, division, factor, multiples

At home you can: continue to practise times tables to support calculations.

Science

Key Learning:

- Forces, including friction, air resistance, water resistance and gravity. We will understand where we see them and how they work.
- Space, including learning about what objects are in our solar system, and how they move in relation to each other.
- Exploring ideas about how day and night are formed.

Key vocabulary: tension, attract, repel, resistance, rebalance, orbit, spherical, solar system, star, sun, daytime, night time, phase

Our values this term are Teamwork and Healthy **Key Learning:**

- To learn how to work as a team to think of strategies in order to make people feel included.
- To understand what makes a healthy friendship.
- To learn that friendships can face challenges and identify some strategies to positively resolve differences.

- Understand the opportunities systems and searching gives.

Art

Key Learning:

- To explore the purpose and effect of imagery
- To understand and explore decision making in creative processes.
- To develop drawn ideas through print making.
- To test and develop ideas.

Key Vocabulary: collagraphy, decision, futuristic, imagery, propaganda, purpose, retrofuturism, technique.

Key Learning:

- To explore food production.
- To research traditional recipes and how to adapt them.

Design Technology

- To analyse nutritional content of food.
- To understand cross-contamination.

Key Vocabulary: cross-contamination, enhance, ingredients, nutrients, recipe, adaptation, balanced, hygiene, process, safety, brand, preference, measure, theme.

Key Learning:

- Remember and recall 12 classroom objects with their indefinite articles.
- Learn about replacing these with a possessive adjective
- Learn how to describe what is and isn't in their pencil cases.
- Learn how to say you live in a house or an apartment

Geography

Key Learning: How is climate change effecting the world?

- Changing patterns of weather at different points across the globe are impacting the lives of real people.
- The key areas of the world and the changes that are occurring.

Key Vocabulary: Africa, The Gambia, rainfall, dry season, desertification, aid, commercial, Oceania, natural disaster, settlement, heatwave.

History

Key Learning: The Battle of Britain

- How serious was the risk of invasion by Nazi Germany in June 1940?
- What did Hitler need to do if an invasion was going to succeed?
- Why did Britain win the Battle of Britain?

Key Vocabulary: Second World War; invasion; Nazi Germany; occupied; territories; speech.

Music

Key Learning:

- How can music express emotions through different musical styles.
- Learn to sing, improvise and compose around the song 'Living on a Prayer'
- Use the glockenspiel to help with learning notation

Key Vocabulary: Rhythmic patterns, melody.

Physical Education

Key Learning:

- How to pass, move and shoot accurately and consistently.
- Execute 'excellent' balances and movements within the Counter Balance and Tension theme, accurately applying flow as they link their balances with movement.

Key Vocabulary: pass, throw, receive, defend, attack, team, balance,

Religious Education

Key Learning: How far would a Sikh go for their religion? Is the Christmas story true?

- Comparing the different ways Sikhs put their religion into practice.
- Evaluate different accounts of the Christmas story and understand that stories can be true in different ways.

Key Vocabulary: Sikhism, Gudwara, incarnation, crib, carols
