### **English**

Texts: Dragon Post, Lost and Found, Look Up!, Dadaji's Paintbrush, The Magic Bed. **Key Learning:** 

- Linking stories to own experiences, discussing what has been read
- To sequence events in books, make inferences and predictions
- Spelling using simple spelling rules; use the suffix -ing, -ed, -er and -est
- Learn the possessive apostrophe (singular)
- To form letters correctly, write on the line and include capital letters and full stops

Class reader(s): A variety of high quality picture books, by a range of authors.

Key Vocabulary: adjective, adverb, character, prefix, suffix, root word, apostrophe.

At home you can: Practise phonics and spellings, read with your child

# Science

## **Key Learning:**

- Observation, classification and identification of plants and trees - including wild and garden plants within our local area
- Where food comes from; growing food

# **Key Learning:**

- Counting in 2s, 5s and 10s
- Equal groups and doubling numbers
- Finding a half and a quarter of a shape and a quantity
- Describing position-left, right, forwards, backwards, above and below.
- Place value to 100
- Days of the week and months of the year
- Telling the time to the hour and half hour

Key Vocabulary: equal, half, quarter, position, pence, pounds, o' clock, half past

At home you can: Practise counting in 2s, 5s and 10s

- Seasonal observations collect and record changes Key Vocabulary: season, weather, sunlight, summer, names of garden and wild plants, crops, parts of plants, including trees, deciduous, evergreen.

- Name and mix primary colours to make secondary colours
- Apply paint consistently to printing materials to achieve a print
- Decorate hands and paint a plate Key vocabulary: primary colours, secondary colours, mix, apply, decorate.

# **Design Technology Kev Learning:**

- Join fabrics together using pins, staples or glue.
- Design a puppet and use a template.
- Join two puppets' faces together as one.
- Decorate a puppet to match their design Key Vocabulary: design, fabric, template,

safety pin, staple, stencil

# Geography **Kev Learning:**

- Understand that some rain water forms puddles and ponds and some flows into streams, rivers and oceans.
- Describe how rivers carry water from the land to seas and oceans.
- Key Vocabulary: streams, rivers, ocean, flood
