English

Texts we will be using: Goldilocks, Wolves, The Journey Home **Kev Learning:**

- Writing narratives about personal experiences and those of others (real and fictional)
- Writing for different purposes
- Use of capital letters, full stops, question marks and exclamation marks to demarcate
- Use expanded noun phrases to describe
- Use subordination (because) and co-ordination (and)
- Evaluating and editing their own writing with the teacher and other pupils

Class readers: Charlie and the Chocolate Factory and one other Roald Dahl book voted for by the class. Key Vocabulary: Noun, adjective, verb, expanded noun phrase, conjunctions, clause

At home you can: Hear your child read/read to them x 5 per week. Practise spellings

Science

Kev Learning:

- Animals groups and their individual needs for survival
- Human's needs for survival- exercise, food, hygiene, teeth
- Natural, human made and recyclable materials

Key Learning:

- Place Value to 100
- Comparing and ordering numbers
- Counting in 2s,5s,10s and 3s
- Number bonds to 10 and 100
- Focus on developing reasoning and explanation skills
- Different strategies for addition and subtraction
- Identifying properties of 2D and 3D shapes
- Finding symmetry in shapes
- Sorting 2D and 3D shapes

Key vocabulary: plus, minus, larger, smaller, greater than, less than, vertices, sides, symmetry, 2D, 3D.

Maths

At home you can: Practise 2, 5, 10 times tables

Key Vocabulary: Animals mammals, birds, fish, reptiles, amphibians and their features, wood, paper, metal, glass, plastic, fabrics, brick

PSHE

Kev Learning:

- Friendships how to maintain them and how to navigate arguments
- Our actions how they can be impactful
- Community what community we belong to and how we contribute
- Our school and locality and how we can look after them

Key Vocabulary: Friendship, relationships, resolve, community, team

Computing

Key Learning:

- Logging on/passwords using Purple Mash
- Online Safety how to use the internet safely
- Search and filters how to use search functions and filters to narrow a search
- Word processing/ power points to create a document using word and power point

Key Vocabulary: digital footprint, attachment, internet safety, emails

Phonics

Key Learning:

- Revisit previously learned graphemes from Year 1
- Revisit previously learned common exception words from Year 1
- New graphemes; dge, g, silent kn, silent gn, le, il el graphemes
- Add suffixes, -ed, -ing, -er, -est
- Year 2 common exception words

Key Vocabulary: grapheme, suffix, phoneme

Key Learning:

Experiment with variety of drawing tools to create tone, line and texture

Art

- Start to draw from observation
- Drawing expressions to illustrate a character
- Develop illustrations to tell a story

Key Vocabulary: blending observation, cross hatching, expression, illustrations, sketch, story board texture, form, line, tone, sketch

Design Technology Key Learning:

- Recognise food groups and balanced meals
- Understand different equipment for preparing food
- Design and make a balanced snack
- Work safely and hygienically
- Evaluate and reflect

Key Vocabulary: balanced, diet, carbohydrates, diary, protein, fruit and vegetables, ingredients design, evaluate

Geography

Key Learning: Why don't penguins fly?

- We will be learning the names of the world's continents and oceans and comparing two climate zones
- Look at the key features of Antarctica and why animals adapted to the environment
- Compare Antarctica with the Sahara Desert looking for similarities and differences

Key Vocabulary: Desert, adapt, climate, continent

History

Key Learning:

- Recognise some of the ways in which the First World War changed how adults were able to behave in Britain
- How were animals used during the First World War?
- How did people communicate?

Key Vocabulary: war, prison, crime; enemy, army

Music

Key Learning:

- Listen to and appraise a range of musical styles
- We will be learning about music from South Africa and exploring a Christmas song called Ho Ho, which includes some rap

Key Vocabulary: Compose, perform, improvise, a steady beat, simple rhythm patterns, pitch, texture, tempo

Physical Education

Kev Learning:

- Locomotion-dodging and defending
- Gymnastics- linking movements and
- Dance-creating animal movements and sequences using rhythm
- Locomotion- Jumping for speed and distance Key Vocabulary: defend, attack, dodge, link, movement, balances, sequences

Religious Education

Key Learning:

- Looking at being kind to others
- Reading stories from the bible that show kindness. For example: The Good Samaritan
- We will be learning about Jesus' teachings, a key festival: Christmas
- Prayer and a sense of belonging to a religion. Key Vocabulary: prayer, kindness, belonging,

worship, bible
