

School Improvement Plan Core Priorities 2026 2027

1. Safeguarding

- a. To ensure a robust Safeguarding culture within governance, senior leadership and all staff, developing leadership in pupils.
- b. Ensuring attendance remains above 96% for all pupils. With an ambition of 98% for the majority of pupils.

2. English Curriculum

- a. More children make at least good progress from their starting points in writing and the percentage of children meeting 'Age Related Expectations' and 'Greater Depth' increases for all year groups.
- b. Continue to develop staff subject knowledge across the English curriculum – with particular focus on writing- to identify gaps in pupils' knowledge, whilst mitigating barriers to learning, so that all children build on outcomes, especially the most vulnerable.
- c. Evaluate the success of phonics and spelling programme.
- d. Review of annual assessment schedule: purpose, procedure, impact.

3. Early Years Foundation Stage

Establish and monitor the EYFS Curriculum and Learning Environment for a mixed-age cohort.

4. Inclusion and Special Educational Needs

- a. Ensure consistency of inclusive SEND provision in line with Ordinarily Available Provision.
- b. Improve progress and academic outcomes for pupils in receipt of Pupil Premium Grant.
