

# Redbourn Primary School School Improvement Plan Core Priorities 2025-2026

### What are we focused on?

# 1. Safeguarding

To ensure a robust Safeguarding culture within governance, senior leadership and all staff, developing leadership in pupils. Ensuring attendance remains above 96% for all pupils. With an ambition of 98% for the majority of pupils.

## 2. Curriculum

- **a.** More children make at least good progress from their starting points in reading, writing and maths and the percentage of children meeting 'Age Related Expectations' for all year groups increases.
- **b.** Continue to develop staff subject knowledge across the curriculum to identify gaps in pupils' knowledge, whilst mitigating barriers to learning, so that all children build on outcomes in all subject's/year groups, especially the most vulnerable.
- **c.** Classroom adaptations to enable the curriculum to be accessible to all.

# 3. Special Educational Needs

- **a**. Ensure consistency of inclusive SEND provision.
- **b**. Make adaptations to the school's curriculum to ensure its implementation enables all pupils to make progress and achieve their full potential, within an inclusive environment.

#### 4. Governance

Governance to be effective through robust strategic and financial planning, succession planning and holding school leadership to account.
