Reading and Home Learning

At Redbourn Primary, we place great importance on supporting children's reading. Each week, your child will read a **Monster Phonics book** in school at least twice to develop fluency and confidence before bringing it home to share with you. In addition, they will take home **two further reading books** to enjoy together over the week, helping to broaden their reading experience and nurture a love of books.

Please ensure Monster Phonics reading books and the reading record are brought into school every day, as the children may have opportunities to read to additional adults if appropriate. Before children are given Monster Phonics books, they will bring home grapheme cards and high frequency words to practise at home.

As well as hearing your child read at home every day, we would like them to access the NumBots App weekly.

Reminders

All children should have a coat and water bottle in school every day.

Woodlands – We plan to go to Woodlands regularly. Please ensure your child has a muddy suit and wellies in school.

Library Day- Library will be on a Friday. Please only send library books in on this day.

Packed Lunches— If your child has a packed lunch, please remember we are a nut free school.
