Are you ready for the ultimate Reception Reading Bingo Challenge? How many squares can you cross off between now and the end of the year? Can you complete a row or even the entire grid?

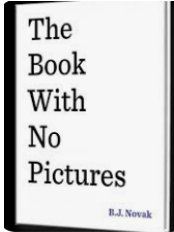
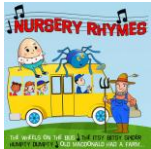
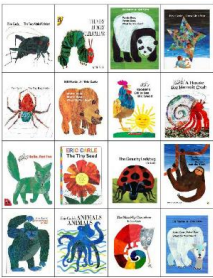
Each book **must** be recorded in your orange Reading Record. You can read the book yourself, have a grown up read it to you or listen to it via an audiobook. When you have completed a square, bring your grid to your teacher, who will sign it off. Some squares have an additional condition! You must be ready to discuss what you have read with your class teacher in order for it to be signed off. Books that you have read in the past do not count but books you are currently reading do.

A lot of these books can be found in local libraries, in our school library or in our class library. If you are registered with a local library, then Borrow Box is a great app where you borrow eBooks and eAudiobooks for free.

You will get a stamp for each square you fill in, a bookmark for each row you fill in and a certificate for completing the whole grid presented in celebrating assembly. What are you waiting for? Pick a square and see where your reading takes you!
